Sports Scholarships 16+

Malvern College has an enviable sporting pedigree and with many past pupils going on to play professional sport. We boast superb facilities and coaching across all sports and offer a range of awards.

All sports scholars are expected to be fully committed to sport at the College and to exercise leadership skills wherever possible both on and off the field of play. They will be excellent role models for all Malvern College pupils to aspire to and will also demonstrate the highest level of sportsmanship. It is expected that sport scholars will show a sustained commitment to sport throughout their time at the College.

Candidates at 16+ will be playing sport to a outstanding level within their age group (be that at County, Regional level or within an Academy). It is recognised that 16+ Scholars will be looking to balance their academic studies and all that Malvern has to offer alongside their commitment and focus on developing themselves in their chosen sport. We therefore provide mentoring and coaching to ensure pupils are able to work towards achieving their goals.

Application

As part of the standard Sixth Form entrance procedure, all external candidates will be required to sit CAT 4 entrance tests. Pupils should sit these entrance examinations during the week beginning **1st November 2021**. Candidates who demonstrate the greatest academic potential in these tests and who have expressed formally an interest in competing for a scholarship by returning a completed entry form will then be invited to attend the Scholarship Assessment Day.

It is anticipated that an award-holder will show commitment to the wider academic, sporting, artistic and cultural life of our College community. The ability to make a meaningful impact on Sixth Form life will also be considered in making the award of a scholarship.

Bathurst 16+ Hockey Scholarship

Assessments will comprise:

Candidates will be assessed on the day in the sport of their choice rugby, hockey, football, netball, cricket and tennis alongside a core movement skills and fitness assessment.

Candidates will also need to demonstrate ability as an exceptional team player and exemplary sportsmanship to be considered for a 16+ sports scholarship.

There will not be a scholarship available in every sport.
